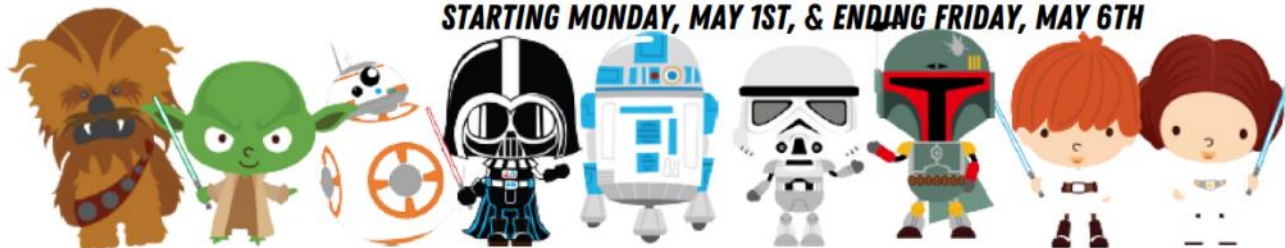

WHAT IS IT?

Penny Wars is a fundraiser where teams compete for the most points. Students/families bring in pennies and/or checks to place in their team jar for positive points, and silver coins and bills to decrease the amount of points in the other jars.

HOW IT WORKS/RULES

- Students are divided into grade-level teams and assigned a collection jar. Staff will also have a collection jar.
- Jars will be located in the entryway in front of the trophy case each morning from 8:30-9am.
- Pennies, Nickels, Dimes, and Checks are positive points.
- Quarters and Bills are negative points.
- Make checks payable to Werner Elementary PTA.
- The money in each class jar will be counted daily. The points will be tallied and announced at the end of each day and posted on the PTA Facebook page.
- Members of the team with the most points at the end of each day (Mon-Thurs) will get extra recess!
- The grade-level team with the most points at the end of the week wins a
VERY SPECIAL TREAT DURING LUNCH.
- Money raised will be used to purchase a new piano.

- \$5 bill: (-) Sub 500 points
- \$10 bill: (-) Sub 1000 points
- \$20 bill: (-) Sub 2000 points

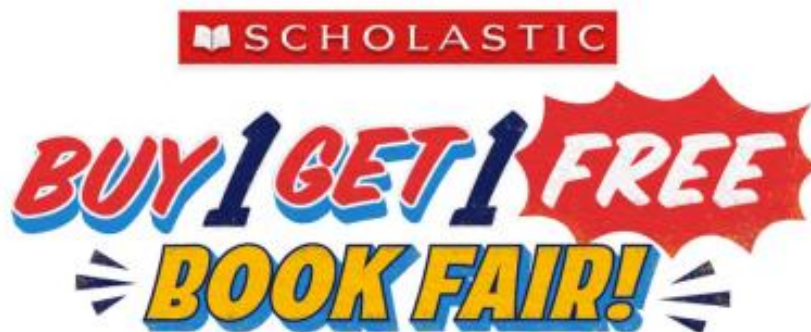
