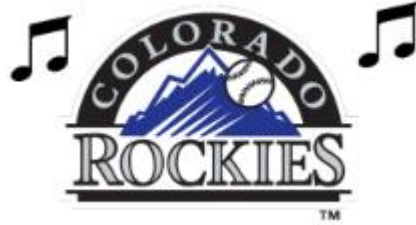

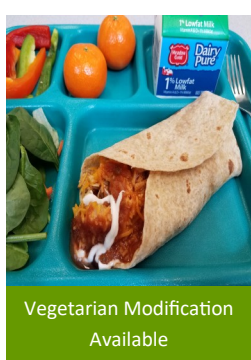

Practice Entering Your ID Number

A great way to teach your child their student ID number is to use the number section of your computer keyboard.

You'll notice that the layout is almost identical to the pin pad that they use at school, except there is no clear button. Just open a word document and let them type in their number and hit enter until they get it memorized and get familiar with actually typing in the numbers.

Experiencing COVID-like Symptoms?

(Fever or chills, Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Fatigue, Muscle or body aches, Headache, New loss of taste or smell, Sore throat, Congestion or runny nose, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea)

Tested Positive

Did Not Test

Tested Negative*



Follow CDPHE Isolation Guidance:

- Isolate for 5 full days*
- If symptoms improving + fever free (without the use of fever reducing medication) may wear a well-fitting mask and return to work/school days 6-10

* Day 0 is the day symptoms begin or date asymptomatic cases tested positive.

Students: Please notify the school's front office or nurse that your child is isolating for COVID-like symptoms or a positive test.

Staff: Report positive or probable cases in Refer-a-Case or have supervisor/CRT report case information.

Follow "How Sick is Too Sick" Guidance.

- * If you are a close contact/ exposed to COVID-19 in the previous 10 days you must have a negative lab test (PCR or molecular) to rule out COVID-19 infection. At-home test results do not apply.

Exposed to COVID-19 in a Household Setting or Issued Quarantine Notice by LCDHE?

Students: Please notify the school's front office or nurse if your child has had a household COVID-19 exposure or LCDHE quarantine notice.

Staff: Please notify your supervisor or CRT team if you have had a household COVID-19 exposure or LCDHE quarantine notice.

Up to Date with COVID-19 Vaccines or Previous Positive COVID-19 Viral Test in Past 90 Days

NOT Up to Date with COVID-19 Vaccines or **NO** Previous Positive COVID-19 Viral Test in the Past 90 Days

Follow CDPHE Recommendations:

- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 full days *
- Monitor yourself for symptoms. Isolate and seek testing if symptoms develop.
- Test on day 5 after exposure if possible.

* Day 0 is considered the last date of exposure to COVID-19.

Follow CDPHE Quarantine Recommendations:

- Quarantine for 5 full days*
- Monitor yourself for symptoms. Isolate and seek testing if symptoms develop.
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others on days 6-10 if you are not experiencing symptoms.
- Test on day 5 after exposure if possible.

* Day 0 is considered the last date of exposure to COVID-19.
